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Whiterock Tower Trail

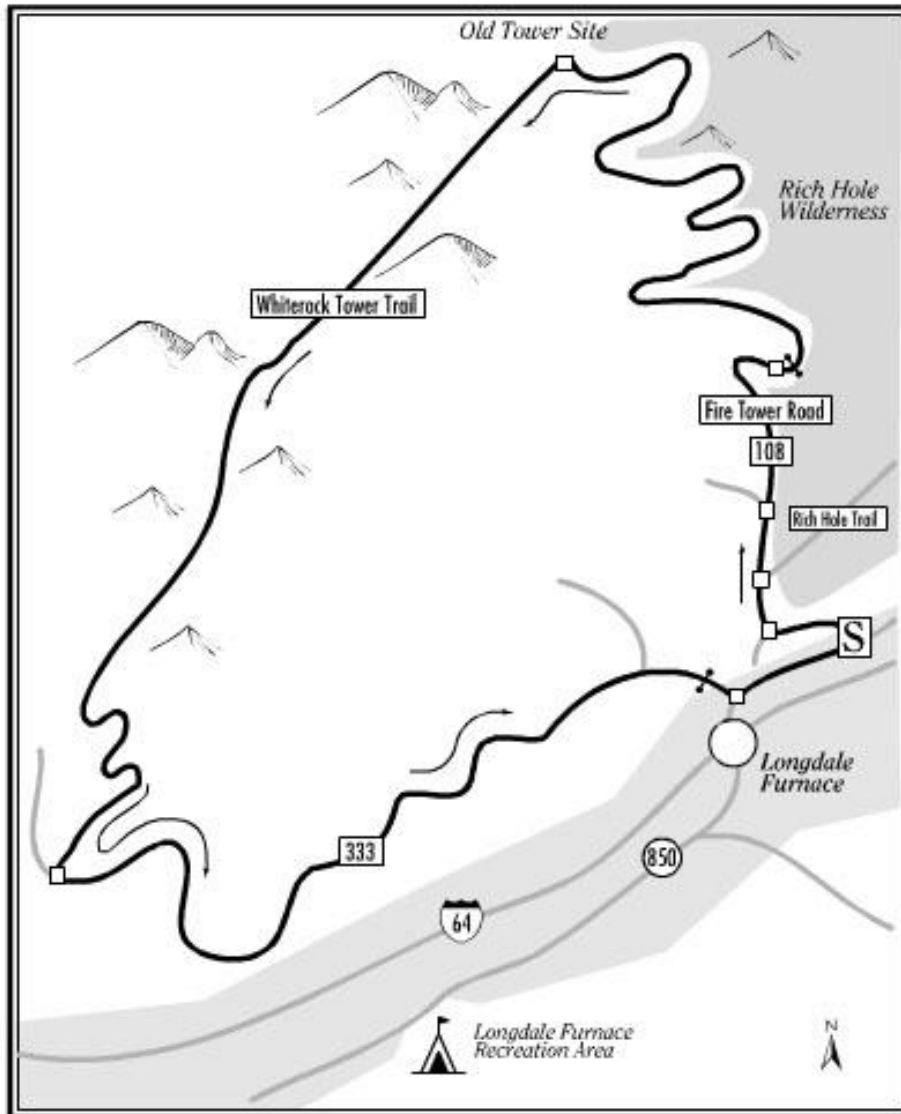
Whiterock Tower is a series of switchbacks on an old forest service road bordering the Rich Hole Wilderness. It takes you up to the remains of Whiterock Tower. On this knife-like spine of a ridge you'll enjoy good views as you ride past house-sized boulders. 16.5-mile loop

- 12-mile loop

Riding Directions:

- From start - ride up fire tower road (FS 108) for 1 mile
- Bear right at fork and go $\frac{1}{4}$ mile
- You'll see Rich Hole Trail to your right - your BEAR LEFT for $\frac{1}{4}$ mile
- Bear right at fork and go 1.5 miles
- Go around gate and ride for another 1.5 miles to old tower site
- Bear left on trail which is marked with faded orange, yellow, and blue blazes
- Ride for ~3 miles
- Turn left on FS 333 and ride for 3.5 miles
- Turn left on Rt. 850 and return to car
